

Academic Major Transfer Requirements (2021-2022)

The terms of internal transfer between the college's majors are:

1. Passing no less than 30 credits and no more than 50 credits.
2. Students cannot change their major more than once.
3. Students must pass "Business Math" course No. (110) with no less than (C).
4. Students must have passed 21 credits (seven courses) from the college required courses with a grade of no less than (C) for each course. The passed courses must include "Principles of Financial Management" No. (220-1012), "Introduction to Financial Accounting (1)" No. (111-1020), and "Principles of Microeconomics" No. (110-1030).

The required courses of the college include:

- "Principles of Financial Management" No. (220-1012).
- "Introduction to Financial Accounting 1" No. (111-1020).
- "Principles of Microeconomics" No. (110-1030).
- "Principles of Management" No. (201-1011).
- "Principles of Marketing" No. (220-1011).
- "Business Statistics I" No. (120-1013).
- "Computer- Based Applications in Business" No. (130-1013)
- "Principles of Quantitative Analysis" No. (205-1013).
- "Introduction to Information Systems" No. (240-1013).
- "Introduction to Financial Accounting 2" No. (112-1020).
- "Principles of Macroeconomics" No. (111-1030).

5. Students must have the following GPA at a minimum to transfer to the majors listed below:

Major	The Required GPA for Transferring
Accounting	3.30
Business Administration	3.10
Marketing and Finance	2.90
Economics and Information Systems	2.70
Operational Management and Public Administration	2.50

The above conditions apply to the accepted students, starting from the academic year 2021/2022
